TRAIL ETIQUETTE

General

- Keep right and stay on the trail
- Do not litter
- Tell someone where you are going and when you expect to return
- Take a cell phone for emergencies

Walkers and snowshoers

- Avoid walking in ski tracks

Cross-country skiers

- Yield to skiers coming downhill

Mountain bikers

- Ride in control at a safe speed
- Use caution on blind corners
- Use a bell or call out when about to pass
- Avoid wet conditions and harsh skids
- Wear a helmet

Dog owners

- Many of the trails are off-leash areas but dogs should be under verbal control
- Scoop your dog's poop
- Restrain your dogs near wildlife
- Keep dogs out of the creek
